SCHOOL AND COMMUNITY

Hungary Creek Middle School opened on September 7, 2004 and currently has approximately 1,000 students. Located in Glen Allen, our school operates with one of the most up-to-date technology systems available including a Maker Hub focusing on 21st Century teaching and learning.

ACADEMIC SCHOOL CHARACTERISTICS:

Block scheduling allows teachers to provide in-depth coverage of content during classes that meet every other day for 90 minutes, with a day 1 / day 2 schedule. The staff uses interactive teaching techniques to challenge and engage our students with the addition of a maker hub. It is our mission to identify the needs of the students and facilitate their learning by making connections between subject areas, maintaining discipline, and communicating effectively with parents and the community to empower students to become self-disciplined, responsible citizens in a global technological society. Hungary Creek is fully accredited based on 2018-2019 SOL results.

FACULTY AND STAFF:

For the 2020-21 school year, there are over 125 faculty and staff serving approximately 1,000 students. The administrative team consists of the principal, associate principal, 2 assistant principals, three administrative aides as well as a part-time dean of student services. The School Counseling department has three full-time school counselors and a registrar.
